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AMENDMENT TO
AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN
THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS
AND
THE MEDIA REVOLUTION, INC.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of the 1st day of January 2011 by and between the City of New Orleans, herein represented by Arnie Fielkow, President of the Council of the City of New Orleans (hereinafter referred to as "City"), and The Media Resolution, Inc. (herein represented by "Contractor").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter the City Council has franchise authority with respect to Cable and Telecommunications providers; and

WHEREAS, the Council has an ongoing interest in the development of the cable and telecommunications infrastructure which serves the City of New Orleans, communications technologies that support the Council in its work, cable access television, legislative, regulatory and compliance issues for cable and telecommunications franchises; and

WHEREAS, to address important Cable/Telecommunications/Technology matters, the Council has selected Cable / Telecommunications /Technology consultant persons and firms and any required subcontractors to assist and advise the Council in accordance with the competitive selection process required by the Home Rule Charter and established by Council Rule 45.

WHEREAS, by Motion M-09-621, after competitive selection, the City Council authorized retention of The Media Revolution, Inc to continue to provide consulting services to

1 the City Council in connection with Technology, Cable and Telecommunications matters; and

2 **WHEREAS**, by Motion M-09-621 and the terms of the Request For Qualifications
3 issued on August 20, 2009, the Council has authorized a new contract with of The Media
4 Revolution, Inc. to provide consulting services to the City Council in connection with
5 Technology, Cable and Telecommunications matters; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Council desires to authorize a contract with The Media Revolution, Inc.
7 to assist in meeting the Council's responsibility to the City and its citizens; now, therefore

8 **WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to engage qualified and professional service
9 consultants to provide cable/telecommunications/technology consulting services to the City
10 Council; and

11 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Motion M-09-621 and the terms of the Request for
12 Qualifications the Council is authorized to renew and extend its existing 2010 contract with The
13 Media Revolution, Inc. for the calendar year 2011; and

14 **WHEREAS**, by Motion M-11-38 adopted on February 3, 2011, the President of the
15 Council is authorized to sign a contract amendment with The Media Revolution, Inc. extending
16 the contract through 2011 and increasing the maximum compensation under such contract by
17 One Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$135,000.00); now, therefore

18 **WHEREAS**, all parties to the agreements dated January 1, 2010 desire to amend the
19 agreement and have the necessary authority to do so.

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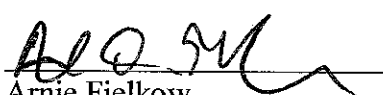
THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED:

1. To increase the maximum compensation payable under the terms of this agreement by "\$135,000.00" thereby increasing the amount on lines 16 and 19 of page 3 of 9 of the Agreement dated January 1, 2010 for The Media Revolution, Inc. The maximum compensation for all services including professional hours and expenses shall not exceed Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$270,000.00). If there are any necessary and ordinary expenses attached to the work of the Firm of The Media Revolution, Inc. these expenses shall be reimbursable by the City but the total amount of such expenses, in addition to the fees shall not exceed Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$270,000.00).
2. To change the termination date of the agreement by deleting the date, "December 31, 2010" on line 7 of page 7 of 9 and inserting in lieu thereof the date "December 31, 2011".

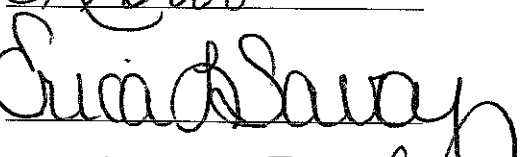

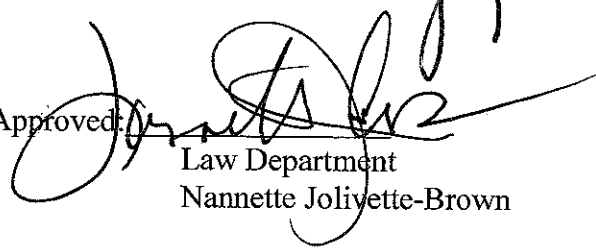
