



**THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED:**

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2 1. To increase the maximum compensation payable under the terms of this  
3 agreement by "\$135,000.00" thereby increasing the amount on lines 16 and 19 of  
4 page 3 of 9 of the Agreement dated January 1, 2010 for The Media Revolution,  
5 Inc. The maximum compensation for all services including professional hours and  
6 expenses shall not exceed Six Hundred Thousand  
7 Dollars (\$600,000.00). If there are any necessary and ordinary expenses attached  
8 to the work of the Firm of The Media Revolution, Inc. these expenses shall be  
9 reimbursable by the City but the total amount of such expenses, in addition to the  
10 fees shall not exceed Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00).

11 2. To change the termination date of the agreement by deleting the date,  
12 "December 31, 2011" on line 7 of page 7 of 9 and inserting in lieu thereof the  
13 date "December 31, 2012".

14 3. Convicted felon

15 The Contractor swears that it complies with Section 2-8 (c) of the Code of the  
16 City of New Orleans. No Contractor principal, member, or officer has, within the  
17 preceding five years, been convicted of, or pled guilty to, a felony under state or  
18 federal statutes for embezzlement, theft of public funds, bribery, or falsification or  
19 destruction of public records.

20 4. Non-Solicitation

21 The Contractor swears that it has not employed or retained any company or  
22 person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for him, to solicit or  
23 secure the subject contract. The Contractor has not paid or agreed to pay any  
24 person, other than a bona fide employee working for him, any fee, commission,  
25 percentage, gift, or any other consideration contingent upon or resulting from the

1 subject contract.

2 5. Inspector General cooperation

3 It is agreed that the contractor or applicant will abide by all provisions of City  
4 Code §2-1120, including but not limited to City Code §2-1120(12), which  
5 requires the contractor to provide the Office of Inspector General with documents  
6 and information as requested. Failure to comply with such requests shall  
7 constitute a material breach of the contract. In signing this contract, the  
8 contractor agrees that it is subject to the jurisdiction of the Orleans Parish Civil  
9 District Court for purposes of challenging a subpoena.

10 6. Ownership Interest

11 The Contractor shall provide a sworn affidavit listing all persons, natural or  
12 artificial, with an ownership interest in the Contractor and stating that no other  
13 person holds an ownership interest in the contractor via a counter letter. For the  
14 purposes hereof, an "ownership interest" shall not be deemed to include  
15 ownership of stock in a publicly traded corporation or ownership of an interest in  
16 a mutual fund or trust that holds an interest in a publicly traded corporation. If the  
17 Contractor fails to submit the required affidavits, the City may, after 30 days'  
18 written notice to the prime Contractor, take such action as may be necessary to  
19 cause the suspension of any further payments until such the required affidavits are  
20 submitted.

21 7. Subcontractor Reporting

22 The Contractor shall provide a list of all persons, natural or artificial, who are  
23 retained by the Contractor at the time of the contract's execution and who are  
24 expected to perform work as subcontractors in connection with the Contractor's  
25 work for the city. In regard to any subcontractor proposed to be retained by the

1 Contractor to perform work on the contract with the city, the Contractor must  
2 provide notice to the city within 30 days of retaining said subcontractor. If the  
3 Contractor fails to submit the required lists and notices, the City may, after 30  
4 days' written notice to the prime Contractor, take such action as may be necessary  
5 to cause the suspension of any further payments until such the required lists and  
6 notices are submitted.


