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AMENDMENT TO
AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN
THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS
AND
THE MEDIA REVOLUTION, INC.

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of the 1st day of January 2013 by and between the City of New Orleans, herein represented by Stacy Head , President of the Council of the City of New Orleans (hereinafter referred to as "City"), and The Media Revolution, Inc. (herein referred to as "Contractor").

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter the City Council has franchise authority with respect to Cable and Telecommunications providers; and

WHEREAS, the Council has an ongoing interest in the development of the cable and telecommunications infrastructure which serves the City of New Orleans communications technologies. These technologies support the Council in its work and in addition, support cable access television; and

WHEREAS, the Council has an ongoing interest in legislative, regulatory and compliance issues for cable and telecommunications franchises; and

WHEREAS, The Media Resolution provides consultancy in service to these Council interests; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Motion M-09-621 and the terms of the Request For Qualifications the Council is authorized to renew and extend its 2012 contract with The Media Revolution for the calendar year 2013; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Motion M-12-473 adopted on December 20, 2012, the President of the Council is hereby authorized to sign a contract amendment with The Media

1 Revolution, Inc. extending the contract through 2013 and increasing the maximum compensation
2 under such contract by One Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$135,000.00); and
3 WHEREAS, all parties to the agreements dated January 1, 2010 desire to amend the agreement
4 and have the necessary authority to do so.

5 **THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED:**

6 1. To increase the maximum compensation payable under the terms of this
7 agreement by "\$135,000.00" thereby increasing the amount on lines 16 and 19 of
8 page 3 of 9 of the Agreement dated January 1, 2010 for The Media Revolution,
9 Inc. The maximum compensation for all services including professional hours and
10 expenses shall not exceed Seven Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand
11 Dollars (\$735,000.00). If there are any necessary and ordinary expenses attached
12 to the work of the Firm of The Media Revolution, Inc. these expenses shall be
13 reimbursable by the City but the total amount of such expenses, in addition to the
14 fees shall not exceed Seven Thirty-Five Hundred Thousand Dollars
15 (\$735,000.00).

16 2. To change the termination date of the agreement by deleting the date,
17 "December 31, 2012" on line 7 of page 7 of 9 and inserting in lieu thereof the
18 date "December 31, 2013".

19 3. Convicted felon

20 The Contractor swears that it complies with Section 2-8 (c) of the Code of the
21 City of New Orleans. No Contractor principal, member, or officer has, within the
22 preceding five years, been convicted of, or pled guilty to, a felony under state or
23 federal statutes for embezzlement, theft of public funds, bribery, or falsification or
24 destruction of public records.

25 4. Non-Solicitation

1 The Contractor swears that it has not employed or retained any company or
2 person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for him, to solicit or
3 secure the subject contract. The Contractor has not paid or agreed to pay any
4 person, other than a bona fide employee working for him, any fee, commission,
5 percentage, gift, or any other consideration contingent upon or resulting from the
6 subject contract.

7 5. Inspector General cooperation

8 It is agreed that the contractor or applicant will abide by all provisions of City
9 Code §2-1120, including but not limited to City Code §2-1120(12), which
10 requires the contractor to provide the Office of Inspector General with documents
11 and information as requested. Failure to comply with such requests shall
12 constitute a material breach of the contract. In signing this contract, the
13 contractor agrees that it is subject to the jurisdiction of the Orleans Parish Civil
14 District Court for purposes of challenging a subpoena.

15 6. Ownership Interest

16 The Contractor shall provide a sworn affidavit listing all persons, natural or
17 artificial, with an ownership interest in the Contractor and stating that no other
18 person holds an ownership interest in the contractor via a counter letter. For the
19 purposes hereof, an "ownership interest" shall not be deemed to include
20 ownership of stock in a publicly traded corporation or ownership of an interest in
21 a mutual fund or trust that holds an interest in a publicly traded corporation. If the
22 Contractor fails to submit the required affidavits, the City may, after 30 days'
23 written notice to the prime Contractor, take such action as may be necessary to
24 cause the suspension of any further payments until such the required affidavits are

1 submitted.

2 7. Subcontractor Reporting

3 The Contractor shall provide a list of all persons, natural or artificial, who are
4 retained by the Contractor at the time of the contract's execution and who are
5 expected to perform work as subcontractors in connection with the Contractor's
6 work for the city. In regard to any subcontractor proposed to be retained by the
7 Contractor to perform work on the contract with the city, the Contractor must
8 provide notice to the city within 30 days of retaining said subcontractor. If the
9 Contractor fails to submit the required lists and notices, the City may, after 30
10 days' written notice to the prime Contractor, take such action as may be necessary
11 to cause the suspension of any further payments until such the required lists and
12 notices are submitted.




