PETITION TO INTERVENE ON THE FOLLOWING POINTS:**

- Net Crediting: a single bill solution should benefit all stakeholders:
 - Developer: not in the best position to bill customers, could cause confusion and added administrative burden.
 - Low-income subscriber: one bill from trusted source (ENO) should help with understanding and attrition.
 - ENO: billing would give utility full visibility on monthly metrics. ENO should be compensated for billing costs by the subscriber organization.
- Deposit: timing of deposit should not used to disincentivize participation but as a mechanism to keep projects moving or withdrawn from queue. The deposit(s) should never be at risk based on ENO's deliverables.
- Explicit language assuring developers that they will have adequate time to get the project back online after a weather event.
- Recertification of low-income subscribers (annual or otherwise) shouldn't be an issue as long as the program designers are comfortable with a certain level of attrition.
