**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of New Orleans (“Council”), on December 15, 2011, adopted Ordinance No. 24,698 M.C.S., relative to the “Cox Communications Louisiana, LLC Cable Franchise” by and between Cox Communications Louisiana, LLC and the City of New Orleans, which included the commitment from Cox Communications Louisiana, LLC (“Cox”) to fund a community grant program; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 7, 2013, the Council adopted Ordinance No. 25,256 M.C.S. to establish the City Council/Cox Communications Louisiana Community Grant Program; to establish eligibility guidelines, selection procedures, and monitoring procedures relative to said program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cox franchise agreement provides for the annual contribution of \$140,000 by Cox to community, non-profit organizations focused upon education, technology training, communications, and similar programs benefitting the youth of the City of New Orleans; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cox franchise further provides that Cox shall make the annual contribution at the direction and discretion of the Council to qualifying organizations; and

**WHEREAS**, there currently exists 2022 annual funding available for distribution, totaling \$140,000; and

WHEREAS, the following groups have demonstrated their commitment to improving the civic life of the New Orleans community through their activities and programs; NOW

**THEREFORE**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS,** That the following grants are approved for funding by City Council/Cox Communications Louisiana Community Grant Program, subject to the organization’s continued eligibility pursuant to the guidelines:
