AMENDMENT TO

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2	AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES BETWEEN
3	THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS
4	AND
5	GRANICUS, INC.
6	THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into as of January 1, 2015 by and
7	between Granicus, Inc. ("Granicus"), a California Corporation represented by
8	Jason Fletcher its CEO, and the City of New Orleans, herein represented by the City
9	Council President, Jason R. Williams (collectively referred to herein as the "Parties").
10	WITNESSETH
11	WHEREAS, on August 4, 2011, the City Council adopted Motion M-11-340,
12	determining that professional services were required to provide a turnkey, comprehensive
13	scalable and flexible agenda preparation and document management system plus an
14	internet video streaming and meetings management solution for New Orleans and directing
15	its staff to issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to begin the competitive selection process
16	established by Council Rule 45; and
17	WHEREAS, a RFP for these professional services for the City of New Orleans was
18	issued on August 15, 2011; and
19	WHEREAS, pursuant to Motion M-12-201 and the terms of the RFP, on June 29,
20	2012 the Council entered into a contract with the firm of Granicus, Inc. to provide these
21	professional services for the City of New Orleans for an initial period from June 30, 2012

1	until Decem	ber 31, 2012, thereafter subject to renewal on an annual basis for a total
2	period of up	to five years; and
3	WHE	REAS, on March 13, 2014, the City Council adopted Motion M-14-67
4	authorizing tl	ne President of the Council to sign a contract amendment with Granicus, Inc.,
5	for an addition	onal annual period from January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014 to provide for
6	the continuati	ion of these services; and
7	WHE	REAS, on April 9, 2015, the City Council adopted Motion M-15-136
8	authorizing th	ne President of the Council to sign a contract amendment with Granicus, Inc.,
9	for an addition	onal annual period from January 1, 2015 to December 31, 2015 to provide for
10	the continuati	ion of these services; and
11	WHE	REAS, all parties to the agreement dated June 29, 2012 desire to extend the
12	agreement, ha	ave the necessary authority to do so, and thus agree as follows:
13	1.	To change the termination date of the agreement by deleting the date,
14		"December 31, 2014 on page 10 of 23 and inserting in lieu thereof the date
15		"December 31, 2015."
16	2.	Convicted felon
17		The Contractor swears that it complies with Section 2-8 (c) of the Code of
18		the City of New Orleans. No Contractor principal, member, or officer has,
19		within the preceding five years, been convicted of, or pled guilty to, a felony
20		under state or federal statutes for embezzlement, theft of public funds,
21		bribery, or falsification or destruction of public records.

3. Non-Solicitation

The Contractor swears that it has not employed or retained any company or person, other than a bona fide employee working solely for him, to solicit or secure the subject contract. The Contractor has not paid or agreed to pay any person, other than a bona fide employee working for him, any fee, commission, percentage, gift, or any other consideration contingent upon or resulting from the subject contract.

4. Inspector General cooperation

It is agreed that the contractor or applicant will abide by all provisions of City Code §2-1120, including but not limited to City Code §2-1120(12), which requires the contractor to provide the Office of Inspector General with documents and information as requested. Failure to comply with such requests shall constitute a material breach of the contract. In signing this contract, the contractor agrees that it is subject to the jurisdiction of the Orleans Parish Civil District Court for purposes of challenging a subpoena.

5. Ownership Interest

The Contractor shall provide a sworn affidavit listing all persons, natural or artificial, with an ownership interest in the Contractor and stating that no other person holds an ownership interest in the contractor via a counter letter. For the purposes hereof, an "ownership interest" shall not be deemed to include ownership of stock in a publicly traded corporation or ownership of an interest in a mutual fund or trust that holds an interest in a publicly traded corporation. If the Contractor fails to submit the required affidavits,

the City may, after 30 days' written notice to the prime Contractor, take such action as may be necessary to cause the suspension of any further payments until such the required affidavits are submitted.

6. Subcontractor Reporting

The Contractor shall provide a list of all persons, natural or artificial, who are retained by the Contractor at the time of the contract's execution and who are expected to perform work as subcontractors in connection with the Contractor's work for the city. In regard to any subcontractor proposed to be retained by the Contractor to perform work on the contract with the city, the Contractor must provide notice to the city within 30 days of

1	retaining said subcontractor. If the Contractor fails to submit the required
2	lists and notices, the City may, after 30 days' written notice to the prime
3	Contractor, take such action as may be necessary to cause the suspension of
4	any further payments until such the required lists and notices are submitted.
