
Ordinances/Motions/Resolutions

1. **Ordinance Cal. No. [32517 pt. 1](#); [32517 pt. 2](#) (Introduced 12/20/18)** by Councilmembers Brossett (By Request)

This ordinance amends the 2018 Capital Budget, de-appropriating \$80,245,404 from various projects which are deemed to have been completed or cancelled and any unexpended but previously appropriated funds shall remain in the originally appropriated source.

2. **Ordinance Cal. No. [32574](#), [32574 FN](#) (Introduced 02/21/19)** by Councilmembers Brossett and Giarrusso (By Request)

This ordinance amends the 2019 Capital Budget, appropriating \$2,300,000 in State Capital Outlay funds for the Sewerage and Water Board Power Plant Construction project. The city is considered by the State as grantee of the funds and Sewerage & Water Board will undertake the construction work.

3. **Ordinance Cal. No. [32583](#) (Introduced 03/14/19)** by Councilmembers Brossett, Giarrusso, Moreno, Nguyen and Gisleson Palmer (By Request)

This ordinance amends the 2019 Operating Budget of Expenditures, transferring federal grant funds in the amount of \$10,000 from the Office of the Mayor, Office of Criminal Justice Coordination to the Health Department. The transfer of the 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Grant Program funds was approved by the Department of Justice to ensure spending of the grant funds. The allocation in the Health Department is to other operating in the Community Alternatives Program.

4. **Ordinance Cal. No. - [32584](#), [32585](#) (Introduced 03/14/19)** by Councilmembers Brossett, Giarrusso, Moreno, Nguyen and Gisleson Palmer (By Request)

These ordinances amend the 2019 Operating Budget of Revenues and Expenditures, appropriating \$154,036 in federal grant funds from Intergovernmental Transfers to the Office of the Mayor – Office of Criminal Justice Coordination. These funds are allocated to other operating funds from the 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Grant Program to purchase various supplies and services.
