WHEREAS, the agreement provides for the total of \$225,000 to be funded semiannually in two payments of \$112,500; and

WHEREAS, the guidelines for eligibility, procedures, and monitoring of the grants have been approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the following group has demonstrated its commitment to improving the civic life of the New Orleans community through its activities and programs; NOW THEREFORE
